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

Erratum The Wood–Anderson of Trieste (Northeast Italy): One of the Last Operating Torsion Seismometers

Electronic Supplement: Earthquake catalog (corrected)

We recently realized that some entries in the earthquake catalog attached as  Table S1 of the electronic supplement to

Sandron *et al.* (2015) are incorrect. The magnitude values in the corresponding M_L column of the first part of the catalog (from the beginning to line 370) contained typographical errors.

This erratum updates  Table S1 of the electronic supplement and provides the correct data for the earthquake catalog. These corrections do not affect the results and the conclusion of the article.
